I declare and acknowledge, in my capacity as parent / authorised representative, as follows towards the Company _____ (the "Organiser") and the owner of the circuit, Santa Monica S.p.A., Via Daijoro Kato no. 10 – 47843 Misano Adriatico (RN) (the "Owner"):

- a. That I am familiar with and consider suitable for the activity the minor intends to carry out the track and its run-off areas, the medical and fire-fighting services arranged by the Organiser for the day, and all active and passive safety measures in place and existing at the time of the activity.
- b. That the minor has a vehicle that is perfectly suitable and already used for the activities he/she intends to carry out at the facility, and I undertake to ensure that the minor wears appropriate clothing and protective equipment while on the track.
- c. That the minor has carefully read the "Regulations" (IL01PSE) currently in force and undertakes to comply promptly and strictly with all provisions, instructions given by authorised personnel, and all indications and prohibitions contained in the signage displayed both on the track and within the circuit premises, as well as on the website misanocircuit.com.
- d. That I acknowledge that the Organiser and the Owner shall bear no liability for any damage of whatsoever nature, including personal injury to the minor and damage to property owned by the minor, in the minor's possession, or owned by third parties, arising from the minor's entry to and presence at the circuit and from the minor's use of the circuit and/or its ancillary facilities, and/or that of the minor's accompanying persons.
- e. That I undertake to indemnify and hold harmless the Organiser and the Owner, as well as any of their representatives, appointees, officers, employees or collaborators, from any liability whatsoever connected with or arising from the minor's entry to, presence at and use of the circuit, including vis-à-vis any third party.
- f. That I confirm, under my own responsibility and being aware of the civil and criminal consequences in the event of false statements, that the minor is in possession of a valid medical certificate attesting to his/her fitness to carry out on-track activities for the current year, and I release the Organiser and Santa Monica S.p.A. from any liability for any physical problems that may arise during the activity and for any related consequences.
- g. That I waive, where necessary, any claim or action against the Organiser, the Owner and the persons indicated in point (e) above for compensation for damages in any way connected with the minor's entry to, presence at and/or use of the facilities, areas and premises of the circuit, as provided under the contract, by the minor or by his/her accompanying persons or collaborators in any capacity.
- h. That I acknowledge full and exclusive responsibility for the custody and supervision of property and persons accompanying the minor and introduced into the circuit (including vehicles), and I therefore assume all liability arising from their use within the circuit and its ancillary areas, undertaking from now to compensate for any damage caused by the minor, directly and/or indirectly, to persons or property, without exception, both on the track and in the ancillary areas and facilities.
- i. That I undertake to promptly communicate to the Organiser, directly or indirectly if unable to do so personally, the minor's details in the event that he/she is involved in an accident during his/her presence within the property of Santa Monica S.p.A.
- j. That I strictly undertake to ensure that the minor does not allow the vehicle to be used on the track, nor within the adjacent facilities, by any person not authorised by the management and who has not signed this declaration, assuming from now all responsibility and any civil, administrative or criminal sanction arising from breach of this provision.
- k. That I strictly undertake to ensure that the minor does not transfer to third parties, even for partial use, the access pass (e.g. wristband), assuming from now all responsibility and any civil, administrative or criminal sanction arising from breach of this provision.
- l. That the minor participates in the activity with suitable vehicle and equipment and has attended the briefing held by the Organiser of the activity.
- m. Data Processing – Each Party acknowledges that the personal data relating to the other Party will be processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR"), which both Parties declare to be fully aware of, and that such data shall be used solely for the purposes necessary to fulfil obligations and carry out activities connected with the performance of this Contract. 

EXTRACT FROM THE REGULATION (IL01PSE)

1 FOREWORD

These Regulations govern access to and presence within the MISANO WORLD CIRCUIT MARCO SIMONCELLI (Circuit). All persons are required to comply with these Regulations and to ensure that they are complied with. Failure to comply with the provisions set out in these Regulations may result in the removal of offenders from the Circuit and/or a claim for compensation, for any damage suffered by the Circuit, against the persons directly concerned and/or their Insurance Companies, indemnifying and holding the Circuit harmless from any Liability arising from failure to comply with the provisions of these Regulations. Any derogations may be granted by Santa Monica S.p.A. (the company managing the Circuit) subject to any required authorisation from the competent Authorities or Governing Bodies. In addition to the provisions set out in these Regulations, the SPORTING REGULATIONS issued by the car and motorcycle federations (FIM-FMI, ACI-FIA) shall apply. The Regulations shall be displayed at various points within the Circuit and shall be available for consultation on the Circuit's Official Website www.misanocircuit.com.

3 ACCESS AND CIRCULATION WITHIN THE CIRCUIT

Access is prohibited to minors under 14 years of age unless accompanied.

Parking of vehicles within the Circuit beyond the official closing time is not permitted, except during specific events for which authorisation has been granted by Santa Monica S.p.A. Vehicles must not, under any circumstances, obstruct internal circulation within the Circuit. Within the Paddock and on the internal circulation roads, the provisions of the Italian Highway Code currently in force shall apply, and circulation takes place without any liability whatsoever on the part of Santa Monica S.p.A. Within the Circuit it is mandatory to proceed at a moderate speed, and in any case at a speed appropriate to the surface conditions, traffic, visibility, the possible presence of pedestrians, etc. In case of congestion, vehicles must proceed at walking pace. Strict compliance with horizontal and vertical signage is required. Drivers must pay attention to speed control devices installed within the Circuit. It is strictly prohibited to use the Paddock areas and service roads for motorcycle and/or car testing, unless such areas have been specifically designated for that use. It is prohibited to drive motor vehicles or motorcycles, including within the Paddock areas, without the appropriate driving licence. All service vehicles used for the transport and handling of goods (trucks, vans, forklifts, etc.) must proceed with the utmost caution and, during manoeuvring, must be assisted by ground personnel. Operators of forklifts or other lifting equipment must hold the appropriate certification (Legislative Decree No. 81/2008). Vehicles must be equipped with the required visual and audible warning devices. Parking of vehicles of any type is strictly prohibited at vehicular access points, stairway and goods lift entrances, fire hydrants, emergency exits, in the vicinity of junctions, and in service areas (Medical Centre, electrical substations, sanitary facilities). In the event of non-compliance with the above provisions, Santa Monica S.p.A. may remove the vehicle from the Circuit at the risk and expense of its owner and of the holder of the access authorization.

4 OBLIGATIONS – REQUIREMENTS – PROHIBITIONS

All persons accessing the Circuit are required to maintain proper conduct, respecting the property and equipment of both Santa Monica and third parties present within the Circuit, and to comply with the provisions issued by Santa Monica at the entrance and within the Circuit by means of appropriate signage, written notices, as well as through the service personnel of Santa Monica S.p.A. and by any other means, it being specified that instructions given by service personnel shall prevail over any other notices. It is prohibited to bring dogs or other animals into the pit garages, the track and all areas where dynamic activities take place. In all other areas, dogs are permitted only if kept on a leash and in compliance with applicable legislation. Guide dogs assisting persons with disabilities and dogs in service with law enforcement authorities are permitted. It is furthermore prohibited to:

- drill, puncture or drive nails and/or screws into walls, ceilings, floors, columns or any other internal or external surface of the Circuit;
- apply loads to structures, walls or lighting poles, even if consisting of lightweight posters, cables, panels or banners;
- soil floors, walls or equipment owned by Santa Monica with paint, glue or other substances, or affix adhesive materials thereto;
- charge cars or other electric vehicles within the premises of the facility (Paddock, car parks, Misano Square) other than at the charging stations authorised and specifically designated for that purpose;
- charge electric scooters and/or electric bicycles within the Circuit buildings (Press Room, meeting rooms, etc.);
- carry out excavations or alterations to the layout of the areas;
- bring into the Circuit explosive, detonating, asphyxiating or otherwise hazardous materials without the required authorisations from the competent Authorities and any prior authorisation from Santa Monica;
- bring in and use Liquefied Petroleum Gas or methane gas cylinders without authorisation from Santa Monica S.p.A.;
- accumulate waste material: as it is generated, the producer shall be responsible for its removal;
- leave within the Circuit any part of installations or residues of any kind.

Any derogations from the above prohibitions must be issued in writing by Santa Monica S.p.A. Santa Monica reserves the right to supplement and revoke the foregoing provisions, and to grant exceptions thereto, by giving notice in the manner deemed most appropriate. Failure to comply with the obligations set out in these Regulations may result in the withdrawal of admission passes and the immediate removal from the Circuit of the persons responsible, as well as – in the case of Vendors or their staff – the temporary or permanent closure of the stand.

6 GENERAL REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO THE CIRCUIT TRACKS

6.1 General Rules

Any vehicle may enter the track only after the driver has presented the relevant valid access pass and has received authorisation from the track official.

Access to the track is subject to the signing of the specific "Assumption of Responsibility" document relating to the type of activity being carried out and to the presentation of the documentation indicated below. Access to the track for ADULT DRIVERS is subject to the following provisions:

- Adult drivers holding a valid driving licence are permitted to enter. The driving licence must be presented in original form; photocopies are not accepted.
- Adult drivers holding a provisional driving permit, a report of loss/theft of the driving

licence, or documentation certifying that the driving licence renewal is in progress are permitted to enter. All documentation must be presented in original form. In such cases, the driver must also present a valid identity document.

- Exclusively for PRE-RACE PRACTICE, adult drivers holding a valid sporting licence for the current year, issued by the competent sporting authority (Federation Internationale de Motocyclisme – Federazione Motociclistica Italiana, Automobile Club d'Italia – Federation Internationale de l'Automobile), are permitted to enter. For access to the track by MINOR DRIVERS, see paragraph 8. Motorcycle riders are required to enter the track wearing a helmet, a one-piece leather suit, gloves and boots. Car drivers are required to enter the track wearing a helmet and fastening their seat belts. Motorcycles entering the track must be of a homogeneous type (e.g. sport motorcycles with sport motorcycles, historic motorcycles with historic motorcycles, supermotard motorcycles with supermotard motorcycles). Motorcycles must not be fitted with licence plates, luggage racks, top boxes or similar equipment, except in the case of parades or similar initiatives. Mirrors, rear and front lights and indicators must be secured with suitable adhesive tape (e.g. duct tape). The use of video recording equipment of any kind (on-board cameras) is prohibited. All motorcycles and cars must be equipped with an exhaust system homologated for road use. The Track Manager has the authority to exclude from the session any vehicles producing excessive noise or fitted with exhaust systems not compliant with road regulations. Drivers are prohibited from allowing their vehicle to be used on track by unauthorised persons or by persons who have not signed the "Assumption of Responsibility" form relating to the specific service. Should drivers fail to comply with this provision, they shall be liable for any civil, administrative and criminal consequences arising from the breach of this prohibition. It is strictly prohibited to transfer to third parties, even for partial use, one's access pass (badge/transponder, wristband, sticker, ticket, etc.). Should drivers fail to comply with this provision, they shall be liable for any civil, administrative and criminal consequences arising from the breach of this prohibition. Furthermore, the representative of Santa Monica S.p.A. is authorised to withdraw the access pass (badge/transponder, wristband, sticker, ticket, etc.) and to refuse entry to any driver who has breached this prohibition. The cost of any damage caused by the user to the track, the facilities and/or third parties shall be reimbursed by the user to Santa Monica S.p.A. and/or directly to the injured parties. Passengers are not permitted in vehicles on track. Passengers are permitted in vehicles only if previously agreed with Santa Monica S.p.A. and after specific insurance policies have been taken out. Professional drivers are not permitted on track during road free practice sessions. Races and betting are prohibited. Drivers are required to strictly comply with the instructions of the personnel on duty (track marshals, pit entry marshals, etc.). Failure by the driver to comply with the instructions given by the personnel on duty and with the provisions contained in these Regulations shall result in the driver being removed from the track and from the facility. During on-track activity, each driver is required to behave in a proper, fair and responsible manner towards other drivers. Drivers must also immediately comply with the instructions communicated by the track personnel, including those conveyed through the display of track signalling flags. Furthermore, along the entire layout of the International Circuit there are 19 LED panels connected to Race Control, and on the start bridge there are two Info Panels and a traffic light system. The positions of the

electronic flag panels on the International Circuit are indicated below. Drivers must familiarise themselves with the signals given by flags; in particular:

Yellow flag: danger signal, displayed in the section preceding the hazard

Red flag: session interrupted, slow down and return to the Pit Lane; on the start/finish gantry the red traffic light will be displayed together with the wording "Session Suspended".

Yellow flag with red stripes: reduced grip of the track surface due to spillage of liquids, rain indication, presence of obstacles on the track

Green flag: track clear, also displayed to indicate the end of the danger zone

Blue flag: a rider/driver is about to be overtaken by a faster rider/driver

White flag: presence of a service vehicle on track (ambulance, fire-fighting vehicle, etc.)

Checked flag: session finished, slow down and return to the Pit Lane.

For other flags, reference is made to the regulations of the federations.

Organisers are required to hold a pre-activity briefing for drivers, whose attendance is mandatory. The briefing concerns the behavioural rules to be observed in the use of the tracks for safety purposes. Santa Monica S.p.A. provides organisers with a video tutorial concerning the behavioural rules for use of the International Circuit.

Participants in Santa Monica free practice sessions are required to view the video tutorial during the registration process for such sessions. The video is available on the website www.misanocircuit.com.

6.2 Sporting Activities

Sporting activities intended as races and competitions are prohibited unless agreed with Santa Monica S.p.A.

For competitions, reference shall be made to the above-mentioned homologations held by the Circuit and to the rules set out in the National and International Sporting Codes (FIM-FMI, ACI-FIA).

6.3 Medical Service

On-track activity must always be carried out with an adequate medical service in place which, depending on the type of activity, must be agreed with the Circuit Medical Director, in order to safeguard the safety of participants and ensure prompt intervention in the event of an accident.

8 MINOR DRIVERS

The following provisions apply to motor activities carried out on all tracks and areas of the Circuit.

8.1 Santa Monica Road Free Practice MOTORCYCLES

Access to the track by minor riders is subject to the following provisions and conditions:

- holding an A category driving licence;
 - use exclusively limited to a registered 125 cc motorcycle;
 - mandatory presence of a parent or legal guardian, who must sign the "Assumption of Responsibility" declaration for track access;
 - the parent or legal guardian must present their identity document;
 - no form of proxy is accepted in lieu of the presence of a parent or legal guardian.
- Track access is permitted only in dedicated sessions.
CARS Track access by minor drivers is prohibited.

8.2 Amateur Free Practice, Timed Practice, Tests Organised by Third Parties, Commercial Exclusive Events MOTORCYCLES

Minors may participate in the above-defined activities in compliance with the following provisions and conditions:

- dedicated sessions and motorcycles with homogeneous characteristics;
- holding a valid sporting licence;
- mandatory presence of a federal technical official, who must present his identity document and his licence;

CARS

Track access for minor drivers is authorised exclusively in compliance with the FIA [Federation Internationale de l'Automobile] Regulations, the Automobile Club of Italy regulations, or other regulations of Federations recognised by the FIA. Minors may not participate in the above-mentioned activities as passengers.

8.3 Pre-Race Practice

Minors may participate in pre-race practice only if the practice sessions are provided for in the Supplementary Regulations of the Event, approved by the respective National and International Federations. In addition, minors must present a sporting licence valid for the current year, issued by the competent sporting authority.

9 DRIVERS WITH DISABILITIES

9.1 Licensed Drivers with Disabilities

All drivers with disabilities holding a sporting licence may access the track by notifying the organiser and the Circuit in advance of the type of disability, in order to inform all track services. The driver shall be provided with a bib and/or an armband for immediate identification on track for service management purposes. The procedures for the issuance of licences are indicated on the websites of the respective Federations.

9.2 Driving Licence Holders with Disabilities

All drivers with disabilities holding a driving licence may access the track, limited to recreational amateur free practice days, by notifying the organiser and the Circuit in advance of the type of disability, in order to inform all track services. The driver shall be provided with a bib and/or an armband for immediate identification on track for service management purposes.

10 ACCESS TO AND USE OF THE INTERNATIONAL CIRCUIT

10.1 Vehicles Authorised to Enter the International Circuit

MOTORCYCLES

At the time of drafting these Regulations, and in accordance with the federal homologations currently in force, which may subsequently be superseded subject to notice, the following vehicles are authorised:

- all road motorcycles (see exceptions), including naked motorcycles;
- all supersport motorcycles

The following are not permitted on the International Circuit:

- off-road motorcycles classified as motocross, enduro and trial;
- "grand cruiser" motorcycles;
- special-type motorcycles such as custom motorcycles.

CARS / TRUCKS

At the time of drafting these Regulations, the vehicles authorised are those provided for by the federal homologations currently in force.

10.2 Use of the International Circuit for Road Free Practice, Amateur Free Practice, Timed Free Practice, Tests

For the procedures governing access to FREE PRACTICE, please refer to the Circuit's Official Website www.misanocircuit.com Vehicles on the International Circuit must circulate in a

clockwise direction. ENTRY TO THE PIT LANE IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED TO UNAUTHORISED PERSONS AND TO MINORS UNDER 14 YEARS OF AGE. Smoking, the use of naked flames and the storage of flammable materials (petrol) are strictly prohibited inside the pit garages. The procedures and the number of vehicles permitted on track at the same time are established by Santa Monica S.p.A.; in the case of competitions, by the competent sporting authority. Drivers are required to strictly comply with the instructions of the personnel on duty (track marshals, pit entry marshals, etc.). Failure by the driver to comply with the instructions given by the personnel on duty and with the provisions contained in these Regulations shall result in the driver being removed from the track and from the facility. During on-track activity, each driver is required to behave in a proper, fair and responsible manner towards other drivers. Drivers must also immediately comply with the instructions communicated by the track personnel and with the provisions set out in these Regulations displayed within the facility. Drivers of motorcycles/cars participating in on-track sessions must maintain a regular driving conduct, avoiding sudden manoeuvres that may jeopardise the safety of other track users. By way of example, and not exhaustively, it is strictly prohibited to:

- reverse direction of travel;
- proceed with zig-zag manoeuvres;
- slow down abruptly without serious and justified reason;
- suddenly occupy racing lines at "low speed" unsuitable for the type of session in progress;
- perform manoeuvres resulting in wheelies;
- stop the vehicle on the track. In the event of a forced stop, the driver must immediately move to a non-hazardous area and wait for the arrival of service personnel;
- rejoin the track, after leaving the circuit layout, without first independently ensuring that re-entry will not compromise the safety of other users present on the track at that point and at that moment.

Motorcycle/car drivers, when entering the track, must proceed along the Pit Exit at a moderate speed and, when merging onto the track, must follow the lane marked with white lines on the asphalt, independently ensuring that the moment of entry does not compromise the safety of other users present on the track at that point and at that time. Drivers intending to return to the pits must signal their intention to the drivers following them. The Track Manager, at his sole discretion and where deemed necessary, may refuse permission for a driver to enter the track. The Track Manager, at his sole discretion and where deemed necessary, may suspend the sessions in progress at any time. If drivers are involved in an accident, they are required to immediately inform the personnel of Santa Monica S.p.A.; if personally unable to do so, they shall, where possible, delegate another person. Should a driver observe any anomaly on the circuit and/or an accident, he/she is required to immediately inform the personnel of Santa Monica S.p.A. In the event of a wet track, the Track Official may authorise entry only to cars or motorcycles fitted with rain tyres. The Track Official, at his sole discretion, for safety reasons, may temporarily suspend the sessions or cancel them definitively. During road car free practice sessions, only road-registered cars with LICENCE PLATES are permitted on track. During road motorcycle free practice sessions, historic motorcycles are not permitted on track except in dedicated sessions.

10.3 Use of the International Circuit During Competitions

During competitions, the rules set out in the National and International Sporting Codes (FIM-FMI, ACI-FIA) shall apply.

16 NOISE IMPACT

On-track activity must be carried out in compliance with the regulations governing noise emissions. The Circuit Management reserves the right to carry out random checks on vehicles present at each individual event, including those for which a specific derogation has been requested. OPEN EXHAUST SYSTEMS ARE NOT PERMITTED, except for activities carried out under derogation and in any case in compliance with the sporting regulations of the competent federations. Any rider required to submit his motorcycle to a phonometer test (noise measurement) before, during or at the end of an event must do so without delay and without removing the motorcycle from the location indicated for the execution of the test. Refusal or delayed presentation of the motorcycle for noise testing shall result in exclusion from the track. Road cars and/or sports cars must also comply with the applicable regulations in force. On-track activity may be suspended at any time by Santa Monica S.p.A. if the values measured by the external acoustic pressure monitoring units exceed the limits imposed by the regulations in force.

26 WASTE AND EFFLUENTS

Within the Circuit there are 4 ecological areas, in addition to the temporary containers set up for separate waste collection during major events. It is prohibited to leave any type of waste, during the set-up, event and dismantling phases, outside the containers provided in the designated areas. Waste must not be placed in transit areas or outside the designated spaces, etc. Residual materials generated during the set-up and dismantling of the areas must be disposed of at the care and expense of the Client or the Installer. Special waste, such as tyres, batteries, carpets and plastic materials, must be disposed of at the care and expense of the Client. Waste oils must be deposited in the appropriate containers located at various points within the Circuit. In the event of accidental spillage of flammable liquids, oils or substances that may render surfaces slippery, the responsible party must promptly arrange for their removal and cleaning. It is strictly prohibited to:

- dispose of in the sewer drainage systems: corrosive water for metals and concrete, paints of any kind, oily or foul-smelling substances, etc.;
- dispose of in the external rainwater drainage pits any type of chemical or organic substance. Oils and fats must be collected and disposed of separately.

Any breach of these provisions shall be subject to sanction.

27 PROVISIONS IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY

For first response in the event of an incipient fire, the Circuit is equipped with its own fire-fighting team and adequate fire-fighting equipment (fire extinguishers, hydrants, etc.). Therefore, upon the occurrence of a dangerous situation, prompt notice must be given to nearby persons, to Circuit personnel, or by calling +39 0541 618568 (Circuit security), providing a detailed description of the situation in progress, the location of the event and the number of persons involved. In the event of fire, in addition to notifying personnel as described above, it is necessary to remain calm and follow the instructions of the designated staff. If an evacuation order is given, do not run or shout and proceed towards the nearest marked emergency exits. In the event of a weather alert, upon receipt of such information, Santa Monica S.p.A. reserves the right to immediately notify the participants in the event, or the event Organiser, in order to allow the adoption of appropriate protective measures.

31 VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

A video surveillance system is installed at the Circuit.

The use of the video surveillance system is deemed necessary for the following reasons:

- protection of the assets of Santa Monica S.p.A.;
- organisational and operational requirements during the conduct of activities;
- occupational health and safety, particularly during the assembly and dismantling of areas and equipment in general in the periods before and after events;
- public safety and public order during major events.

The processing of data through video surveillance is carried out lawfully, for specific and legitimate purposes in accordance with the applicable data protection legislation. Law No. 300/70 (Workers' Statute) as amended and supplemented is expressly complied with. Santa Monica S.p.A. undertakes to comply with the principle of necessity in data processing; therefore, unnecessary uses are excluded and excessive redundancy is avoided. The video surveillance system operates 24 hours a day and recordings are retained for no more than 2 days, equivalent to a maximum of 48 hours, without prejudice to special requirements for extended retention in relation to public holidays, closures, socio-political events, adverse weather events, etc., as well as in the event of a specific request by the Judicial Authority or the Police. Any video footage of incidents on track and/or in any other area of the Circuit shall be provided, if still available, exclusively upon request by the competent public security authorities. Any other request not complying with the above shall not be accepted. The recorded images are not directly accessible to third parties. The system containing the recordings is accessible only to authorised persons and is equipped with the minimum security measures required by the applicable data protection legislation.

As provided for by the applicable legislation in force, appropriate signs bearing the following information are displayed in clearly visible positions at the locations subject to recording or in their immediate vicinity:

- Area subject to video surveillance
- The data collected will be used for security and access control purposes
- They will not be used for other purposes.
