





STOPPING A FREE PRACTICE SESSION OR A QUALIFYING SESSION

When the red flags/lights are displayed, all Drivers must immediately reduce speed being prepared to stop if necessary and proceed slowly back to the Pit Lane - Pit Allocation.

All abandoned Cars will be moved to a safe position. Any lap time recorded after the red flags have been displayed will not be taken into account.






STOPPING A FREE PRACTICE SESSION OR A QUALIFYING SESSION

WHEN THE RED FLAGS/LIGHTS ARE DISPLAYED, ALL DRIVERS MUST IMMEDIATELY REDUCE SPEED BEING PREPARED TO STOP IF NECESSARY AND PROCEED SLOWLY BACK TO THE PIT LANE.

ALL ABANDONED CARS WILL BE MOVED TO A SAFE POSITION. ANY LAP TIME RECORDED AFTER THE RED FLAGS/LIGHTS HAVE BEEN DISPLAYED WILL NOT BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT.

STARTING PROCEDURE

- **15' (fifteen minutes)** before the announced departure, the cars will leave the Pit Area.
- Will be allowed, in the interval between the opening of the pit lane and its closure,


 To make two (2) laps of the circuit, driving through the Pit lane until the green light is on.
- **10' (ten minutes)** before the start time is announced, the PIT Exit will be closed. Any car still in the Pit Area will be allowed to start only after the whole group has passed the Pit Lane End while doing the first lap.
- <u>05' PANEL</u> Access to the grid is closed; any car that is not in its position on the Grid, must start from the back of the Grid . From 05' panel no operations on the car finish all work.
- <u>03' PANEL</u> everybody except drivers, officials and team staff in charge of the external starting device, must leave the grid.
- <u>01' PANEL</u> engines must be started immediately and all Team personnel, except the Drivers, must leave the Grid.
- 30" PANEL after this panel is shown, a green flag will be waved before the grid to indicate that the cars must move on to complete a full lap of the circuit

GREEN FLAG – FORMATION LAP

STARTING PROCEDURE

Grid Marshals will stand behind the Pit Wall, alongside each Grid position with boards showing the grid position until the car concerned is completely stopped

Any Driver who stops their Car forward or off-centre of the position prescribed by the lines on the Grid, shall be penalised with Stewards Decision.



EXTRA FORMATION LAP

If the Starter decides that the start must be delayed because a Car involving in a problem or another problem, flashing yellow light - (abort start)



FORMATION LAP

Practice starts are forbidden during the Formation Lap and the formation must be kept a as tight as possible.


Any drivers who is unable to start his car must immediately raise his arm; when the other cars have lift the grid, the car will be pushed into the pit by the mechanics. During this manoeuvre if the driver is able to restart can rejoin the formation lap and he will take the <u>last place on the grid</u> at the end of the formation lap.

After the green flag if a driver is delayed while leaving his position on the start grid, he can resume his pre-start position on the grid if he is not passed by all the others cars which started the formation lap. If he 's passed by all other cars started on the formation lap, this driver must start the race from the back of the formation

When the Cars return to the Grid at the end of the Formation Lap , they must stop on their respective Grid positions keeping their engines running

DURING THE FREE PRACTICE – QUALIFYING AND RACES



IN CASE OF USING THE "FULL COURSE YELLOW", THE RD WILL COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING STANDARDS SPEED LIMIT IMPOSED THE ENTIRE OF TRACKS IS 80 KM/H; IN THIS CASE, AT EACH MP, WILL BE SHOWED THE BOARD FCY (FULL COURSE YELLOW) WHICH WILL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A WAVED YELLOW FLAG, MAINTAINING THE SAME DETACHMENT FROM OTHER CARS, UNTIL THE FIRST MP WHERE THE GREEN FLAG WILL BE DISPLAIED. AT END OF THE FCY PROCEDURE—ENTRY INSIDE THE TRACK THE SAFETY CAR, BEFORE THE RESTART.

FOR THAT REASON IS FORBIDDEN, FOR THE DRIVERS MAKE WARMING TYRES DURING THE RACES – IMPORTANT SAFETY MATTER !!

PIT EXIT LIGHTS DURING SC

Pit exit light remain **GREEN**



The Safety Car will join the Track with its orange lights illuminated and will join the Track regardless of where the Race leader is.



While the Safety Car is in operation, Cars may enter the Pit Lane, but may only rejoin the Track when the green light-flag at the Pit Exit is switched on.

The green light-flag will remain on at all times except when the Safety Car and the line of Cars following it are about to pass or are passing the Pit Exit.

A Car rejoining the Track must proceed at an appropriate speed until it reaches the end of the line of Cars behind the Safety Car.

•It is not permitted to undertake the DRIVE THROUGH or Stop & Go Penalty during a SC deployment .

Pit lane exit light is green, unless the SC and the field are approaching or passing the PIT EXIT



Under certain circumstances, the Race Director may ask the Safety Car to use the Pit Lane. In these cases, and provided its orange lights remain illuminated, all Cars must follow it into the Pit Lane without overtaking.



Any Car entering the Pit Lane under these circumstances may stop at its Pit




When the Race Director calls in the Safety Car, it must extinguish its orange lights and this will be the signal to the Drivers that it will be entering the Pit Lane at the end of that lap.

If the Safety Car is still deployed at the <u>beginning of the last lap</u>, or is deployed <u>during the last lap</u>, it will enter the Pit Lane at the end of the last lap and the cars will take the chequered flag as normal without overtaking.

SAFETY CAR RESTART



START BEHIND SAFETY CAR

Under certain circumstances the Race may be started behind the Safety Car. In this case, at any time before the "one-minute" signal is given, its orange lights will be switched on. This is the signal to the Drivers that the Race will be started behind the Safety Car. When the green lights are illuminated, the Safety Car will leave the Grid with all Cars following in Grid order, no more than ten car lengths apart. There will be no Formation Lap and the Race will start when the green lights is on.



Any Driver who is delayed leaving the Grid must not overtake another moving Car if they were stationary after the remainder of the Cars had crossed the Start Line.

This Driver must then take up position at the back of the line of Cars behind the SC

SUSPENDING AND RESUMING A RACE



The Pit Exit will be closed and all Cars must proceed to the grid where they must stop

They will then resume the race in accordance with the Regulation

The Safety Car will then be driven to the front of the grid

A race which has not been declared **WET** before the start will not be interrupted if , during its course, it starts raining, and drivers will be allowed to use rain tyres .

START BEHIND SAFETY CAR



When the green lights are illuminated, the Safety Car will leave the Grid with all Cars following, in the order they were positioned behind the Line, no more than ten car lengths apart. Soon after the last Car in line behind the Safety Car passes the Pit Exit, the Pit Exit lights will be turned green and any car in the Pit lane may enter the Track and join the line of Cars behind the Safety Car

RESUMING A RACE

The Safety Car will enter the Pits after **one lap** if all Cars are in a line behind the **SAFETY CAR**



If the Race cannot be resumed for any reason, the results will be taken at the end of the penultimate lap before the lap during which the signal to suspend the Race was given

- If the drivers don't respect the Sporting Regulation
- If the drivers have caused a collision
- If the drivers don't respect flag signalling



YELLOW FLAG



* <u>Single Waved</u>: Reduce your speed, do not overtake, and be prepared to change direction.



DOUBLE YELLOW FLAGS

*<u>Double Waved</u>: Reduce your speed significantly, do not overtake, and be prepared to change direction or stop.

BLUE FLAG



At ALL TIMES: displayed to a driver leaving the pits if traffic is approaching on the track.

During PRACTICE: a faster car is close behind you and is about to overtake you.

During the RACE: shown to a car about to be lapped, the driver concerned must allow the following car to pass at the earliest opportunity.


