




TROLLEYS CIRCULATION IN PIT LANE










TIMING SECTORS ON TRACK









TRACK LAYOUT







STOPPING FREE PRACTICE - QUALIFYING - RACE

When the red flags/lights are displayed, all Drivers must immediately reduce speed being prepared to stop if necessary and proceed slowly back to the Pit Lane - Pit Allocation.

RED LIGHTS PANEL

Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking

Qualifying: Clock stops - lap time cancelled - drive to pit lane



RED FLAG DURING THE FP AND QUALIFYING: STOP THE CAR IN THE PIT ALLOCATION IN WORKING LANE ONLY – MANDATORY IN CORRECT POSITIONS OF THE PIT ALLOCATION.

CHECK THE RED FLAG PROCEDURE - DURING SAFETY CAR ON THE ACISPORT REGULATIONS (RDS 2024)


RESTART THE RACE IS BEHIND THE LA SAFETY CAR – FOLLOW THE ITALIAN SPORTING REGULATION 2024.

CARS FIRST POSITIONING IN THE GRID SUPERSPORT SERIES SAFETY PROCEDURE:

DURING POSITIONING ON THE STARTING GRID, ALL SPACES OF EACH CAR MUST BE IN ORDER THE TROLLEYS MUST BE KEPT EXCLUSIVELY OUTSIDE THE TRACK - THE ASSISTANTS MUST NOT INTRUDE INTO THE CENTRAL POSITIONING AREA – ALL TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT MUST BE POSITIONED IN FRONT OF EACH RESPECTIVE CAR IN ORDER TO MAKE THE POSITIONING MANOEUVRES EASY AND SAFE.

TROLLEYS POSITIONING ON THE GRID

All the trolleys must be positioned close to the pit wall for the cars that will start on the RHS of the starting grid and to the grandstand side for the cars that will start on the LHS of the starting grid. No trolleys are allowed to be positioned in the middle of the starting grid

1' BEFORE THE START WILL SHOW THE PANEL 1' MINUTE: STARTING GRID IN **COMPLETE CLEAR CONDITIONS - ENGINES ON**

30" BEFORE THE START WILL SHOW THE PANEL 30" SECONDS: DRIVERS MUST BE READY FOR THE FORMATION LAP

AFTER WILL SHOW THE GREEN FLAG: ALL CARS MOVING FROM THE GRID FORMATION (STARTING) LAP

In the interval between the opening and the closing of the pit lane, 2 (two) laps of the circuit can be driven, with passage along the Pit Lane and within the time period in which the green light is on

When the cars are stopped in the GRID before the Formation Lap – ENGINE OFF / NO ENGINE RUNNING






Abort the Start



FULL COURSE YELLOW

FCY PROCEDURE

- During free practices and qualifying the FULL COURSE YELLOW procedure could be used.
- A 10 seconds countdown will be carried out before the start of the procedure.
- All Marshals posts will show a waved yellow flag and a FCY board.
- From this moment, all drivers must reduce the speed to 80 Km/h and maintain it constant.
- OVERTAKING IS FORBIDDEN.
- When safety conditions will be restored another 5 seconds countdown will be carried out and at the end of it all the yellow flags and FCY boards will be withdrawn and replaced with waved green flags.

DURING THE FREE PRACTICE – QUALIFYING AND RACES



IN CASE OF USING THE "FULL COURSE YELLOW", THE RD WILL COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING STANDARDS SPEED LIMIT IMPOSED THE ENTIRE OF TRACKS IS 80 KM/H; IN THIS CASE, AT EACH MP, WILL BE SHOWED THE BOARD FCY (FULL COURSE YELLOW) WHICH WILL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A WAVED YELLOW FLAG, MAINTAINING THE SAME DETACHMENT FROM OTHER CARS, UNTIL THE FIRST MP WHERE THE GREEN FLAG WILL BE DISPLAIED. AT END OF THE FCY PROCEDURE—IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE ENTRY INSIDE THE TRACK THE SAFETY CAR—BEFORE THE RESTART.













SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE

- If needed, the Clerk of the Course can use the Safety Car to neutralize the race.
- When the Safety Car deploy order is given, all Marshals Post will show a waved yellow flag and SC board.
- The Safety Car will enter on track with the yellow lights on and take the head of the race with the leader behind itself.
- Overtaking is forbidden and the distance should be less than five car lengths apart.
- The Safety Car will be used until the safety conditions will be restored.
- When the Safety Car will approach the SC Line 1, competitor may enter in pit lane overtaking the SC.
- During the SC procedure Pit Exit remain GREEN. When the SC will close to pass the START Line pit exit will be closed (RED lights)
- When the last car of the group behind the SC will pass pit exit the light at pit exit it will be GREEN again.
- In some circumstances, the Safety Car can pass in pit lane. Please, always follow the Safety Car when its yellow lights are on.
- During the SC period it's not possible to serve penalties as STOP & GO and DRIVE THROUGH











PIT EXIT LIGHTS DURING SC






When the order is given to deploy the Safety Car, all Marshals posts will display wawed **yellow flags** and the <u>"SC"</u> board which shall be maintained until the intervention is over







FIRST SAFETY CAR LINE







The Safety Car will join the Track with its orange lights illuminated and will join the Track regardless of where the Race leader is.



While the Safety Car is in operation, Cars may enter the Pit Lane, but may only rejoin the Track when the green light-flag at the Pit Exit is switched on.

The green light-flag will remain on at all times except when the Safety Car and the line of Cars following it are about to pass or are passing the Pit Exit.

A Car rejoining the Track must proceed at an appropriate speed until it reaches the end of the line of Cars behind the Safety Car Maximum distance behind the safety car for the leader is 25 meters (mandatory).

Pit lane exit light is green, unless the SC and the field are approaching or passing the PIT EXIT









Under certain circumstances, the Race Director may ask the Safety Car to use the Pit Lane In these cases, and provided its orange lights remain illuminated, all Cars must follow it into the Pit Lane without overtaking.

Any Car entering the Pit Lane under these circumstances may stop at its Pit





Under certain circumstances, the Race Director may ask the Safety Car to use the Pit Lane; in these cases, and provided its orange lights remain illuminated, all Cars must follow it into the PIT LANE without overtaking.

Any Car entering the Pit Lane under these circumstances may stop at its Pit

During the SAFETY CAR period it's not possible to make the penalty

- -- STOP&GO
- -- DRIVE TROUGH



SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE

- When the Clerk of the Course announces "Safety Car in this lap," the Safety Car will turn off its yellow lights at Turn 15/16
- From this moment onward, all drivers must maintain a consistent speed without performing any tire-warming maneuvers. All SC boards will be withdrawn and a single fixed yellow flag will be show at each marshal pos
- As the Safety Car approaches the pit entry, the yellow flags will be withdrawn.
- Green lights and a green flag will be displayed only at the Control line until the last car passes.
- Overtaking is only allowed after crossing the Control/Finish line.
- If the safety car remains on the track during the final lap, the following procedure will be implemented:
 - Turn off lights at Turn 15/16
 - Safety car returns to the pit lane
 - All competing cars will receive the chequered flag (no overtaking or green flag).


To avoid accidents during the restart, from the moment the lights are switched off, the leader and all cars will have to maintain a constant speed, without any maneuvers that can lead to an imperfect phase of restart

NO TYRE WARMING DURING THE RESTART PROCEDURE REMAIN IN ONE SINGLE LINE

Overtaking remains forbidden until the Cars cross the Finish Line







Overtaking remains forbidden until the Cars cross the Finish Line – Control Line

If the Safety Car is still deployed at the <u>beginning of the last lap</u>, or is deployed <u>during the last lap</u>, it will enter the Pit Lane at the end of the last lap and the cars will take the chequered flag as normal without overtaking.

Each lap completed while the Safety Car is deployed will be counted as one Race Lap

STOPPING A FREE PRACTICE SESSION OR A QUALIFYING SESSION

WHEN THE RED FLAGS/LIGHTS ARE DISPLAYED, ALL DRIVERS MUST IMMEDIATELY REDUCE SPEED BEING PREPARED TO STOP IF NECESSARY AND PROCEED SLOWLY BACK TO THE PIT LANE.

ALL ABANDONED CARS WILL BE MOVED TO A SAFE POSITION. ANY LAP TIME RECORDED AFTER THE RED FLAGS/LIGHTS HAVE BEEN DISPLAYED WILL NOT BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT.

SUSPENDING AND RESUMING A RACE





The Pit Exit will be closed and all Cars must proceed to the grid where they must stop
They will then resume the race in accordance with the Regulation
The Safety Car will then be driven to the front of the grid

A race which has not been declared **WET** before the start will not be interrupted if , during its course, it starts raining, and drivers will be allowed to use rain tyres .



In this case, at any time before the "one-minute" signal is given, its orange lights will be switched on. This is the signal to the Drivers that the Race will be started behind the Safety Car. When the green lights are illuminated, the Safety Car will leave the Grid with all Cars following in Grid order, no more than ten car lengths apart. There will be no Formation Lap and the Race will start when the green lights came on






At ALL TIMES: displayed to a driver leaving the pits if traffic is approaching on the track.









