

Drivers must use the Track at all times. The white lines defining the tracks edges, are considered to be part of the Track but the kerbs are not, and, a Driver will be out the Track limit, will be judged by the stewards. Respect the track limit at all times.



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PRE GRID LOCATION








Any Driver intending to leave the Track or to enter the Pit Lane shall signal their intention to do so in good time and shall make sure that it is safe to do so. At all times, access to the Pit Lane is allowed only through the Pit Entry.








# SPEED LIMIT IN THE PIT - 60 KM/H

#### DURING THE START OF A RACE, THE PIT WALL MUST BE KEPT CLEAR OF ALL PERSONS




SPEED LIMIT IN THE PIT 60 KM/H

A red light and a green light will be placed at the Pit Exit during a Qualifying Session. Cars may leave the Pit Lane only when the green light is on. Additionally, a flashing blue light or a waved blue flag may be shown at the Pit Exit to warn Drivers leaving the Pit Lane if Cars are approaching on the Track

### **MARSHALL POST**



If you have problems on track pls move your car near the Marshall Post Entrance (in the left or right side on track)



#### STOPPING A FREE PRACTICE SESSION OR A QUALIFYING SESSION

When the red flags/lights are displayed, all Drivers must immediately reduce speed being prepared to stop if necessary and proceed slowly back to the Pit Lane. All abandoned Cars will be moved to a safe position. Any lap time recorded after the red flags/lights have been displayed will not be taken into account.





In the interval between the opening and the closing of the pit lane, 2 (two) laps of the circuit can be driven, with passage along the Pit Lane and within the time period in which the green light is on .

At the end of the second lap, the vehicles take their assigned places on the Grid and turn off their engines.



### TURN 11-12 CARS RANGED IN TWO LINES












#### Abort the Start



If for one or more reasons the start can not be given, the red lights will be on and the blincking yellow lights will be on.

LIGHT YELLOW BLINCKING ON - LIGHT RED ON:

IN THIS CASE NEW FORMATION LAP - SPEED DICTATED BY POLE POSITION

**EXTRA FORMATION LAP** 

Repairs are admitted during the race (free practices, qualifying...etc,) and must be performed only within the allotted assistance area in front of the box and in accordance with the current Regulation.

Only four (4) people, may work on each car in front of the PITs, and only authorized people for each competitor car may access the pit.

#### Refuelling in the pit lane is strictly forbidden during the whole event

To replace the tires may be used, at the same time, a maximum of two (2) guns screwdrivers.

Drivers, inside the vehicle, must switch the engine on using the starter; if necessary it is allowed to use a backup battery for restarting the engine.

Autodromo Vallelunga

Drivers are not allowed, in any case, to push their vehicle or have it pushed, penalty of exclusion from the race.

The transmission of any signal is forbidden from and to a vehicle in motion during official practices and/or the race, save the transponder timekeeping signal and for the driver radio.

#### **FULL COURSE YELLOW**

#### **DURING THE FREE PRACTICE-QUALIFYING AND RACES**



IN CASE OF USING THE "FULL COURSE YELLOW", THE RD WILL COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING STANDARDS SPEED LIMIT IMPOSED THE ENTIRE OF TRACKS IS 80 KM/H; IN THIS CASE, AT EACH MP, WILL BE SHOWED THE BOARD FCY (FULL COURSE YELLOW) WHICH WILL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A WAVED YELLOW FLAG, MAINTAINING THE SAME DETACHMENT FROM OTHER CARS, UNTIL THE FIRST MP WHERE THE GREEN FLAG WILL BE DISPLAIED. AT END OF THE FCY PROCEDURE—IT IS POSSIBLE THE ENTRY INSIDE THE TRACK OF THE SAFETY CAR—BEFORE THE RESTART. DURING THE RACE WARMING TYRES IN FORBIDDEN.

### **SAFETY CAR**



When the order is given to deploy the Safety Car, all Marshals posts will display wawed **yellow flags** and the <u>"SC"</u> board which shall be maintained until the intervention is over

### SAFETY CAR

The Safety Car will join the Track with its orange lights illuminated and will join the Track regardless of where the Race leader is.



While the Safety Car is in operation, Cars may enter the Pit Lane, but may only rejoin the Track when the green light-flag at the Pit Exit is switched on.

The green light-flag will remain on at all times except when the Safety Car and the line of Cars following it are about to pass or are passing the Pit Exit.

A Car rejoining the Track must proceed at an appropriate speed until it reaches the end of the line of Cars behind the Safety Car.

Pit lane exit light is green, unless the SC and the field are approaching or passing the PIT EXIT

#### **SAFETY CAR**

Under certain circumstances, the Race Director may ask the Safety Car to use the Pit Lane; in these cases, and provided its orange lights remain illuminated, all Cars must follow it into the PIT LANE without overtaking.

Any Car entering the Pit Lane under these circumstances may stop at its Pit


During the SAFETY CAR period it's not possible to make the penalty

- -- STOP&GO
- -- DRIVE TROUGH



To avoid accidents during the restart, from the moment the lights are switched off, the leader and all cars will have to maintain a constant speed, without any maneuvers that can lead to an imperfect phase of restart

#### **SAFETY CAR - RESTART**

Overtaking remains forbidden until the Cars cross the Finish Line



If the Safety Car is still deployed at the <u>beginning of the last lap</u>, or is deployed <u>during the last lap</u>, it will enter the Pit Lane at the end of the last lap and the cars will take the chequered flag as normal without overtaking.

Each lap completed while the Safety Car is deployed will be counted as one Race Lap

#### **SUSPENDING AND RESUMING A RACE**



The Pit Exit will be closed and all Cars must proceed to the grid where they must stop

They will then resume the race in accordance with the Regulation

The Safety Car will then be driven to the front of the grid

A race which has not been declared **WET** before the start will not be interrupted if , during its course, it starts raining, and drivers will be allowed to use rain tyres .

### START BEHIND THE LA SAFETY CAR




Under certain circumstances the Race may be started behind the Safety Car. In this case, at any time before the "one-minute" signal is given, its orange lights will be switched on. This is the signal to the Drivers that the Race will be started behind the Safety Car. When the green lights are illuminated, the Safety Car will leave the Grid with all Cars following in Grid order, no more than ten car lengths apart. There will be no Formation Lap and the Race will start when the green lights came on




\* <u>Single waved</u>: Reduce your speed, do not overtake, and be prepared to change direction.

\*<u>Double waved:</u> Reduce your speed significantly, do not overtake, and be prepared to change direction or stop.
